The Penticton Farmers' Market asks that all buskers take note of the following rules and regulate themselves accordingly. The market manager reserves the right to speak to any busker not in compliance, and may ask them to leave the market if necessary.

1. BUSKER RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- It is FREE to busk at the Penticton Farmers' Market; however, we require your contact information.
- Busking spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Buskers must arrive **before 8:30am** and an application must be filled out before performing.
- The Penticton Farmers' Market can accommodate up to five buskers or groups each Saturday. Please space yourself accordingly (not near other buskers).
- **Buskers are asked to move themselves every 30 minutes.** At the end of each busking set, please rotate NORTH (towards the lake) to a new busking location. The busker at the north end of the market will proceed to the south end.
- **Please ask the neighbouring vendors if they would mind if you busk next to them.** Some of our vendors have hearing conditions that make it challenging for them to hear when music is too close. Please respect this.
- **Amplification is not permitted.**
- Please dress appropriately. A neat and clean appearance is most appealing.
